AHCA/NCAL would like to tell you about a new tool called Capwiz·XC that we are now using. It allows activists to become more familiar with and actively influence the policies that affect our profession. Capwiz·XC contains updated legislative data and online tools that allow you to have an active role in the political process.

Some of the features of this new tool are:

- **Sign Up For Our Mailing List** - Sign up for email alerts through our advocacy home page. Submit your email address and contact information to quickly find out about issues that affect us in Congress and at the state level.
- **Take Action** - Alerts can be found on our organization's website. Send personalized messages to officials and policymakers and let them know what you think. Click on an alert to find an easy process by which you can contact your representatives. Select the recipients and the type of message. Fill out your contact info to verify that your message was sent from an individual and not generated by a computer.
- **Research and Contact Elected Officials** - Contains a comprehensive government directory that is updated regularly. Keep up with changes of legislators and their staff members here.
- **Use the Interactive Map to Find Your Elected Officials** - Click on your state or enter your zip code to learn who your elected officials are. From there you can see each legislator's bio page. Each bio page includes direct links to contact the legislator, look up key votes, and find staffs contact information.
- **Bills and Votes** - Allows you to keep track of important bills and votes. Click here to learn more.
