Mountain Valley are recipients of the 2005 and 2020 *Bronze - Commitment to Quality* awards, 2007 and 2021 *Silver -Achievement in Quality* awards, and 2011 and 2022 Gold awards. In 2016, the center was the first skilled nursing care center in the nation to earn the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award.

Highlights

- Five-Star Overall Quality Rating: Mountain Valley has maintained its CMS Five-Star Overall Quality Rating—the highest possible—since inception of the program in 2009 and has been sustained through economic downturns and the national pandemic.
- Senior Leadership Rounding: Established as a best practice, Senior Leadership Rounding resulted in quality outcomes and sustained satisfaction and engagement among residents, families, and staff. 100% of employees surveyed would recommend Mountain Valley to others as a good employer and to a family member for care.
- Resident Satisfaction: 100% of Mountain Valley residents and family members surveyed have expressed either "very" or "extreme" overall satisfaction levels since 2013, which is above the national industry average by 28% for residents and by 14% for families.
- **Deficiency Free:** Mountain Valley has zero deficiencies from the State of Idaho Department of Health including two COVID-19 focus infection surveys resulting in zero citations.
