# AHCA/NCAL Building Trust Leadership Academy



A professional development program for leaders in nursing homes and assisted living communities that focuses on core skills to ensure staff feel heard, valued and trusted

AHCA/NCAL is providing leaders the opportunity to improve trust in their organizations through a Building Trust Leadership Academy. The Leadership Academy is a virtual 15-week interactive program with easy-to-use tools and resources to help leaders build trust with staff.

# Who is this Leadership Academy for?

This session is for long term care leaders and managers, both clinical and non-clinical. This includes administrators, DONs, senior leaders, department heads, infection preventionists, quality improvement leaders and unit leaders.



## What will I gain from this Leadership Academy?

After completing the leadership academy, participants will be able to:

- Work with leaders across your facility to build trust to achieve facility goals such as increasing vaccine uptake, improving patient safety and addressing staff wellbeing
- Assess the presence of trust in your facility
- Identify the impact of inequities in building trust
- Address people's resistance to change

- Ask open-ended honest questions and listen for understanding in conversations with staff
- Use motivational interviewing techniques to build trust and secure commitments
- Address misinformation in a culturally sensitive manner
- Facilitate psychologically safe conversations among teams





#### **Course Outline and Schedule**

#### **January 8 – February 12, 2024**

  - 45 minutes of practice reflections in your facility
  - 15 minutes of sharing experience and resources with colleagues

#### **Course Commitment**

- Participants must be able to engage in all calls and complete course work and pre-work.
- Participants will use Zoom web conferencing for live sessions. This requires a stable internet connection, webcam and working microphone.
- Applicants are encouraged to enroll with another team member from their facility with whom they can practice the skills and offer one another feedback and support.
